Remarks:

Tickets to The Palace Museum ("Forbidden City"), the visit at The Great Wall and other special exhibitions are not included!

Costs:

Program and Housing Fee: 1.800 EUR

The fee includes all sessions, an organizational fee and housing in a double room (Hong Kong and Beijing). It doesn't include the trip and entrance fee for the Palace Museum and the Great Wall.

Flight:

Approx. 900 EUR with Air China (recommended because of stopover in Beijing).

Estimated total costs Program, Housing and Flight: 2.700 EUR

Additional Costs:

- MEALS
- Tourism Visa, Food, Transportation in Hong Kong and Beijing, Site Visits

The program fee and the housing fee will be collected by DHBW. Students will be reimbursed in case the actual costs are lower than indicated here.

IMPORTANT: Students from DHBW Mannheim will be supported by the PROMOS Scholarship, offered by DAAD. The scholarship is approx. between 180-225 EUR/student, depending on the number of participating students. Students will get more information once the application is completed.
